





Recording a Butterfly Transect

This training is for anyone interested in learning how to record a butterfly transect. Butterfly transects are typically 1-2km in length and are walked weekly during a 26-week period between 1st April and 29th September each year. Data recorded are submitted to UKBMS – The UK Butterfly Monitoring Scheme.

The day will be run by volunteers from Butterfly Conservation Sussex and will include a classroom-based introduction on how to record a transect, how to set up a transect and how to identify butterflies, followed by an opportunity to practice recording techniques in the stunning Knepp Wildland.

Visitors may wish to bring a packed lunch as the Knepp Wilding Kitchen is some distance from The Granary - the transect training venue.

Suitable footwear and outdoor clothing is recommended.

The event is free of charge, but donations are welcome.
