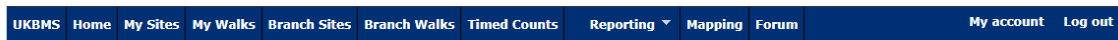


Adding data to the UKMBS Site

2. Select “My Walks from the menu
